Ceremony to dedicate new plaque

The city of Glendale will honor local residents who have lost their lives in military service at 2007 Annual Memorial Day Ceremony at 9:30 a.m. on May 28 at the Glendale Veterans Memorial.

Dedicated in 1997, the memorial features four panels with the names of local residents who died in World War I, World War II, the Korean War and Vietnam War.

This year, the city will dedicate a new panel to six local residents who died in recent service in the Middle East.

Family members of the servicemen and women whose names are engraved on the new panel have been invited to attend the event, which will feature honorary guest speaker Maj. Gen. William H. Wade II from the California National Guard.
